

Trustees Committee Meeting Minutes March 9, 2023 – 5:30 pm

*** Minutes Discussion Comments are in BOLD ***

- Call to Order note attending and absent Present Lewis Fry, Ian Arvizo, Eric Deleon, David Sisler, Dave Drown
- Prayer -
- Review and approval of prior meeting minutes Moved by Lewis and 2nd by Ian, Approved

Old Business:

- 1. Trustees meeting to continue at 5:30 pm on the 2nd Thursday of each month.
- 2. Jim Mailhes has created an email list of church members that have agreed to received periodic "We need Help With" emails. Current confirmed members are Gaye Hensley, Red Christensen, John Fry, Bill Jolly, Larry Jolly, Kenneth Greer.
- 3. Who will be the new primary contact person to receive initial requests from church staff when something breaks or needs to be done. Sue Ellen has done this in the recent past. *** Dave Drown when here and then Don Moerbe when David is in PA
- Who will be chair, co-chair, secretary, etc. *** Jim Mailhes Chair, Dave Sisler Vice Chair, Don Moerbe Sec. These positions are also the Trustee reps at the monthly Admin One Board meeting which are the 4th Monday each month at 6 pm. All church members are welcome to attend.
- 5. Since we are no longer limited to nine Trustees members. Let's brainstorm a list of church members who can be on a "Can you help us with this request" email system. Maybe we can get past Trustees and/or other members to help do some of the things we are doing. *** name given to Jim and he has contact some of them. These persons are still being solicited and will be an ongoing project.
- 6. Status of current projects per the December Minutes report *** 1) side entrance handrail installed by Jim and Larry Jolly, 2) Thermostats installed by Trent AC employee John on 2/9/23 Jim total estimate for bill would be about \$300 *** 6 remote sensors were donated by Tim Stephens and installed in early March.
- 7. Hope sent me this the other day...... I need help the banners need to be rehung in the Worship Center. They are currently stored in the WC closet for easy access. The Christmas decorations have all been removed, so trustees are welcome to work on the banners at your convenience. If I need to contact someone else to ask for help, just let me know. – *** Ian did it
- 8. Dave Drowns info about pot hole repair Dave's email ---- He said he could do it for \$2000 because he needed the work. It normally would charge \$2700 for this work. He asked if a lower cost would clinch the deal. Don and I said we needed to talk to others and would get back to him. I believe his name is Bill (?) Jeffries which was painted on his truck. 16 pot hole repairs would take a full load of hot mix. I await his bid. I would then have him walk the parking lot again and spray paint the areas to patch. The Ad Board thought this was worth doing. Probably not budgeted for 2023. *** We will monitor. We discussed price of doing limited repairs ourselves using Home Depot/Lowes product and Dave Drown will fill one pothole and report back cost/effort and effectiveness.
- 9. CLC commode valve leak David Drown **The material has been located and David will complete the project.**

- 10. Staples Street LED sign issue Dave Drown has researched the problem and will attempt to get Chris Christensen to assist and Don Moerbe is available also. Likely need to replace part of an LED panel.
- 11. Report by Dave Drown on the rat problem is CLC. THREE rats killed is March 1st and none in last few weeks. We will likely ask Daniel to fix the rat damaged telephone fiber cabling when Travis starts the install of the new phone system not that we feel we have the rats handled.
- 12. Discuss a date for finishing the metal roof fastener chalking job. This will be scheduled but not believed to be an emergency. We took pictures of the ceiling in the Sanctuary of stained tile caused by water and if they grow, we know we have a problem and location.
- 13. Jim Mailhes called the our pest control company, Pest Patrol and was told they provide quarterly service and and call out for ants/bugs, etc. When we told them about the rats issue they put out sticky traps at no charge. They do charge \$22 per outside rat trap box and \$6 to refill them each time. Jim provide Dave Drown with rat bait and we rebaited a few of the working outside traps and will monitor.
- 14. Cathy, finance administrator, supplied us with a Transaction Detail By Account for 2022 that lists all expenditures charged to the trustee account and list vendors. Jim Mailhes distributed to trustees via email.

New Business:

- 1. Tad wants to borrow the Ga Ga inflatable ball pit game for an Agape Ranch Agape Ranch event on May 6th for potential adoptive Parents & available Children to adopt, to have a fun day to give an opportunity to hang out and meet. The last several years around 40 Children have been adopted. We would take very good care of it. Pick up & deliver it back. It would really provide some fun for the kiddos. Jim got approval from Trustee present as long as an Asbury member doesn't need to use it at the same time. Jim called Kat and she said no one will need it at that time so Jim told Tad it is available.
- 2. In preparation for the church Disaffiliation vote:
 - Quotes for church lability and property insurance. Jim M. is doing this
 - Listing of signage, banners, letterhead, etc that would need to be replaced or just removed if go to GMC. What might it cost to remove and replace anything with those trademarked items? **Trustee** estimate of about \$5,000 but they will get quotes of church votes to disaffiliate.
- 3. Kitchen range Hood Suppression System Renewal letter from 2/27/23. Review the letter and discuss and see who will arrange the inspection in April 2023. Dave Drown will contact the inspection service listed on the City of CC letter..... "Guard Master Fire & Safety" to arrange the inspection in April per the letter.
- 5. Other items.... A) Lewis offered to have the small engine mechanic at his work look at the church's chainsaw and/or other chainsaw's, blower etc. to tune them for use at the next Spring Clean. We need to trim a mesquite next Staples street identified by Dave Drown. B) Due to the continued leaking issues with the gym hallway drinking fountain we discussed removing it and offering the use of our 5-gal Igloo jugs for ice water if b-ball teams and/or other groups want access to water. We will bring this up for discussing at the One Board meeting.
